



Association Swimming Pools, Spa, and Decks

There is no lifeguard on duty. Residents and guests swim at their own risk.

Residents and guests are required to respond immediately to management's (staff's) request to leave the pool.

Residents and guests must obey the posted rules which reflect Florida Statutes and Pinellas County Ordinances for the operation of pools and spas.

Use of the Swimming Pools, Spa and Decks:

The Clubhouse Pool and Spa, the Lodge Pool and the Decks at both pools are owned and maintained by the Association and are provided solely for use by Association residents in good standing and their guests.

Residents are required to have their Resident Recreation Tags with them when using the pools, spa and decks. Guests are required to wear Guest Tags. Guests under eighteen years of age must be supervised by a Resident Sponsor at all times and are NOT allowed in the Spa.

Residents must pick up the Guest Tags for their guests at Resident Services during business hours.

During scheduled use of the Clubhouse pool by approved groups, the pool will remain open provided the presence of other swimmers does not interfere with the group's scheduled activity. The needs of the scheduled group take precedence over that of other swimmers.

Lap swimmers are encouraged to use the Clubhouse pool early in the day and in the evening. The Clubhouse pool is not a designated lap pool and lap swimmers are not entitled to exclusive use of the pool at any time.

General Rules of Conduct:

Residents are responsible for their actions as well as the actions of their guests. Any resident or employee may file a complaint to Administration for improper conduct or abuse. A complaint form is available at Resident Services.

Everyone is expected to:

- **Read and follow the rules posted at the pools, spa and deck areas.**
- Take a shower sufficient to remove dirt, oil and lotion before entering or re-entering pool or spa.



- Wear a bathing suit. Jeans or cut-offs are not allowed. Rubber soled beach shoes or sandals are acceptable in the pool as long as they have not been used as street shoes.
- Do NOT DIVE or jump into the pool.
- Running and horseplay are prohibited in the pool area.
- Use towels to cover chairs used in the pool area and decks.
- Only water in plastic containers may be consumed on the pool deck. All other food or drinks must be consumed on the upper pool deck or in the Pavilion. No glass containers allowed.
- Dry off and wear cover-ups and shoes to enter the Clubhouse or Lodge.
- Only small float devices such as noodles, water wings or donuts may be used. Rafts, inner tubes, toys or balls are not permitted.
